You also have the option of using any clock or timepiece of your choice. Either way, we hope you will choose to share your talent and creativity in support of *It’s About Time*.

The pieces for the auction will be selected at the discretion of the curator. If unsold at auction, clocks become the property of **G-CAPP**.

Clocks may be picked up beginning **July 1** at the **IKEA** Atlanta receptionist desk, located through the staff entrance, between 10am and 8pm.

All artwork must be delivered to **G-CAPP** by **August 15** in order to be considered for the city-wide preview event, and no later than **September 15** for inclusion in the keepsake auction catalog.
